→ Student:

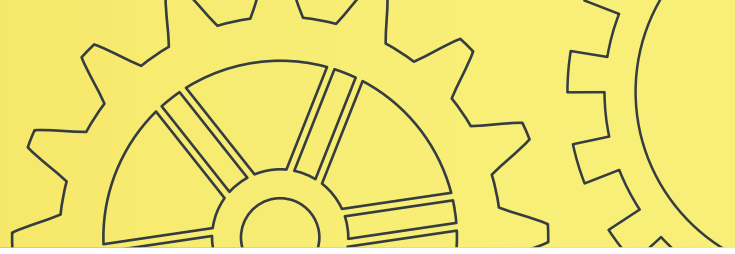
- Provides engaging and relevant work integrated and project learning opportunities through coursework.

→ What other cities are involved?

- There are currently 15 CityStudios in municipalities globally—12 across Canada as well as one in Norway and two in Australia.

→ How do we adapt the model here?

- The model is designed specifically to adapt to local contexts. It's been proven to work in diverse municipalities and regions of all sizes nationally and globally—with populations less than 20,000 to over 1m!

→ What kinds of projects are done?

- Projects can take on a variety of forms based on the needs of the municipality, such as research, analysis, mapping, and prototyping. Projects can focus on a range of issues, for example, the climate emergency, equity and inclusion, food security, health and wellbeing, public spaces, and transportation.

→ How much does it cost?

- The fee structure is population-based. Get in touch with us to learn more and get a quote for your municipality.

→ How long does it take?

- Depending on local stakeholders, the process can take anywhere from a few months to one year.

→ What's the first step to getting started?

- Interest and buy-in from municipal and academic leadership is the first step.

→ How is it organized?

- A CityStudio can be organized inside a municipality or an academic institution, or as a program inside a nonprofit organization, depending on what suits the local context.

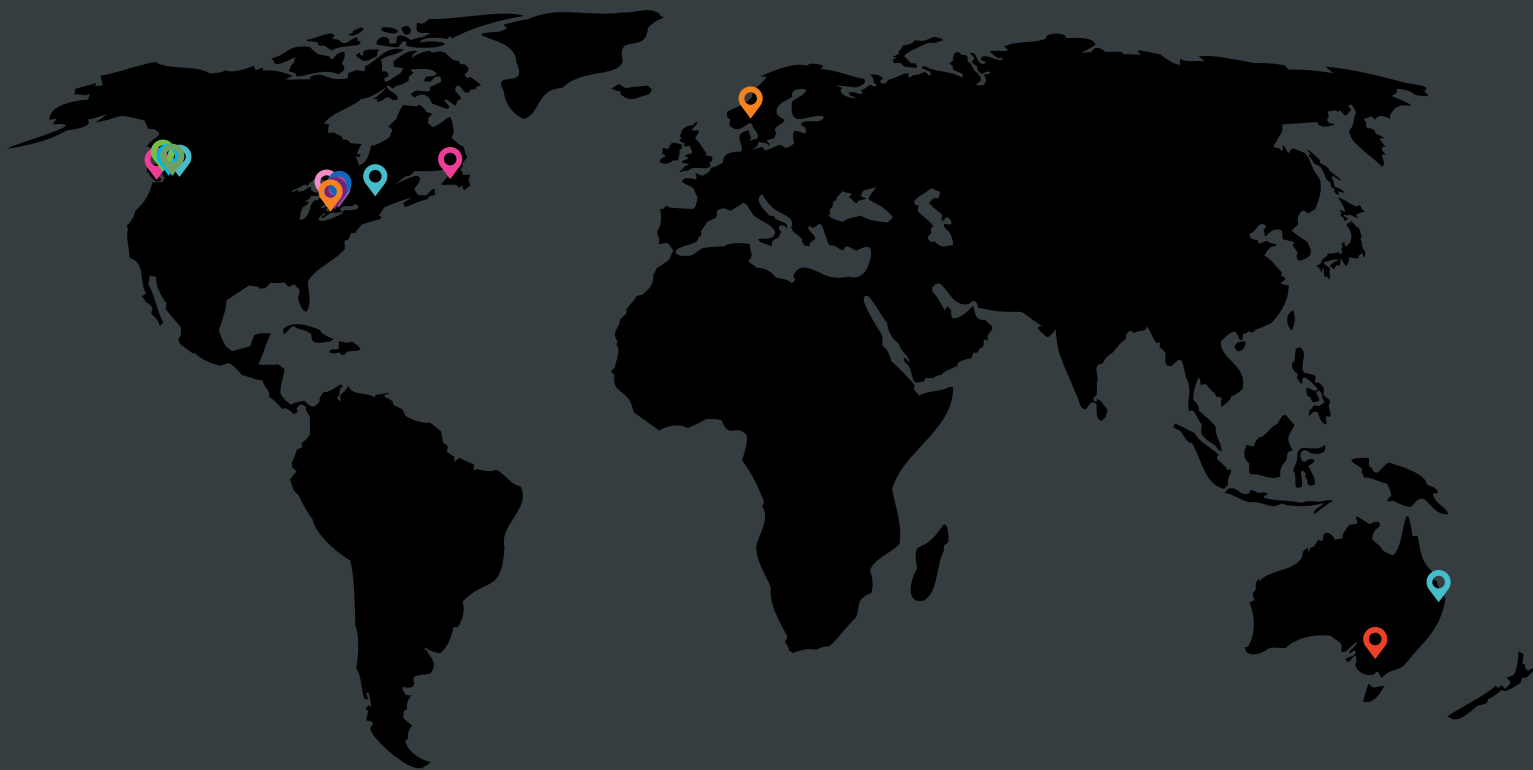

→ 5 Steps to Create the Best Municipal-Academic Partnerships

1. **Hire a Project Coordinator** to organize the work, develop relationships, and find project opportunities.
2. **Host an annual project development workshop** with city staff, where the Project Coordinator discovers what's going on in the municipality and what staff need help with.
3. **Create a project scoping and matching process** to find the right fit between the needs of city staff and the skills of students in alignment with course curriculums.
4. **Develop relevant and practical course-based projects** for students that directly support the municipality's needs.
5. **Hold a project showcase** to bring together students, city staff, municipal and academic leadership, and citizens to share project outcomes and envision next steps.
